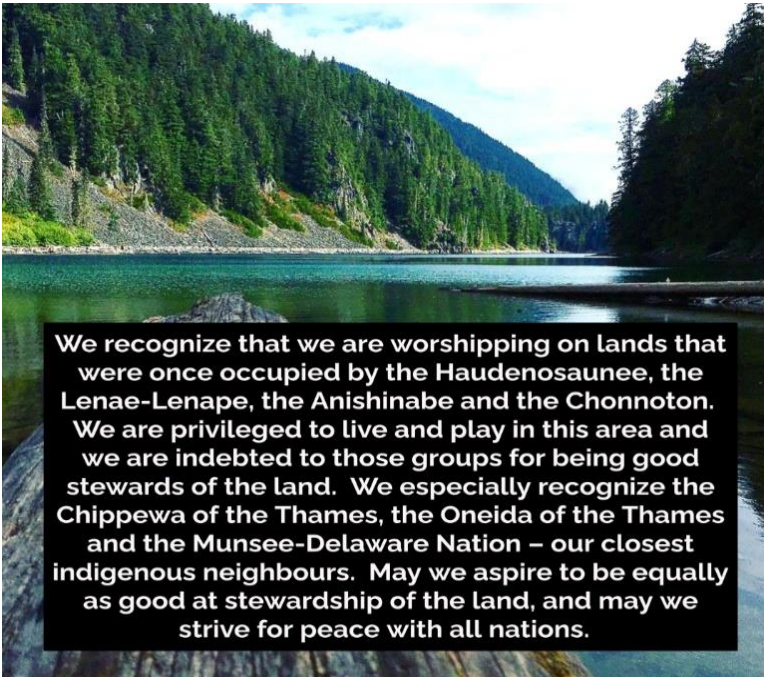
Official Board MEETING

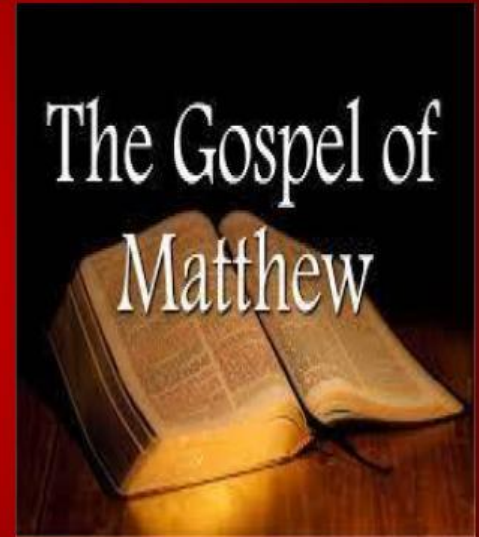
